



DL Frequent Flyer Guide: Rewards, Benefits & Status

The DL frequent flyer program, better known as Delta SkyMiles, is Delta Air Lines' loyalty program for travelers who want to earn miles and receive additional travel benefits. Membership is free, and SkyMiles do not expire. Members can earn miles through eligible Delta flights, partner airlines, travel purchases, credit cards, hotels, car rentals, dining, and other participating partners.

What Is Delta SkyMiles?

Delta SkyMiles allows travelers to earn rewards from qualifying purchases and flights. Members can use accumulated miles for Award Travel, upgrades, Delta Vacations packages, and selected travel benefits.

The program is useful for occasional travelers as well as frequent flyers because there are multiple ways to earn miles beyond flying. Travelers can also access special SkyMiles offers and partner opportunities to build their balances faster.

How to Join the DL Frequent Flyer Program?

Joining SkyMiles is free and can be completed through Delta's official website. After creating an account, members receive a SkyMiles number that should be added to eligible reservations.

New members can begin earning miles immediately on qualifying travel and participating purchases. Keeping the SkyMiles number connected to bookings helps ensure eligible mileage is credited to the correct account.



How to Earn Miles by Flying?

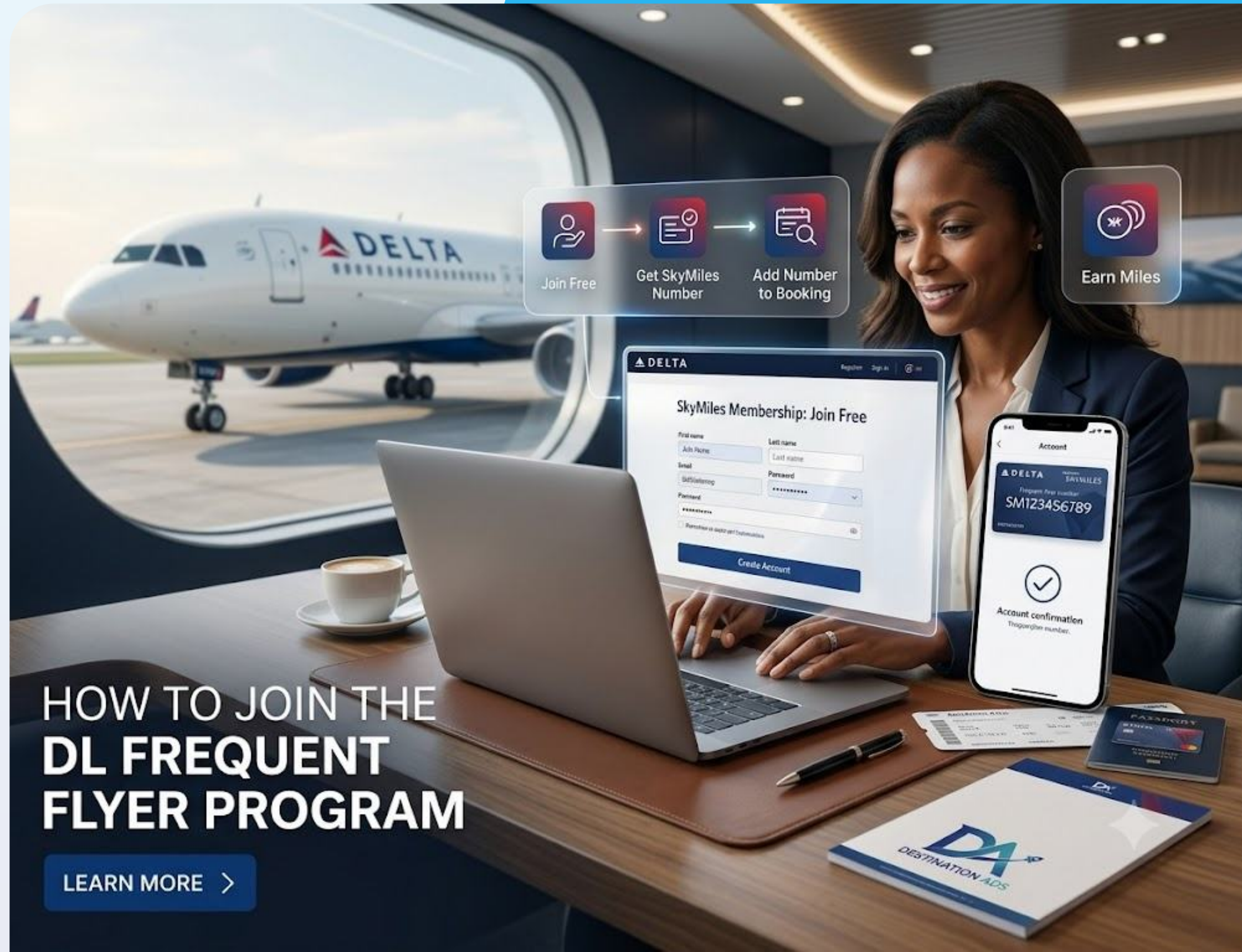
One of the simplest ways to earn SkyMiles is by flying with Delta. Current earning depends on the travel experience purchased. Delta says eligible SkyMiles members earn 5 miles per dollar on Classic or Refundable experiences and 7 miles per dollar on Extra experiences on Delta-marketed flights. Delta Main Basic tickets do not earn miles.

The miles are generally based on the eligible ticket price rather than simply the number of miles flown. Taxes and government-imposed fees are excluded from the mileage calculation.

Earn Miles Through Partners

The DL frequent flyer program extends beyond Delta flights. Members can earn miles through more than 20 airline partners, including airlines such as Air France, KLM, LATAM, Aeromexico, and Virgin Atlantic.

There are also opportunities to earn through hotels, car rentals, shopping, dining, ridesharing, and other participating businesses. Partner earning rules vary, so travelers should check the terms for each partner before making a purchase.



Delta SkyMiles Credit Card Benefits

Eligible Delta SkyMiles American Express Card Members can earn miles through everyday purchases and receive additional opportunities to increase their balances.

Depending on the card, members may receive different earning rates and travel-related benefits. Delta states that certain cards can provide additional miles on eligible Delta purchases. Card benefits, fees, and promotional offers vary, so travelers should review current terms before applying.

How to Redeem SkyMiles?

SkyMiles can be used in several ways. Members can redeem miles for Award Travel to more than 1,000 destinations, Delta Vacations packages, seat upgrades, and certain other travel benefits.

Delta also allows members to use miles toward standard checked-bag fees on flights originating from select U.S. airports. Since redemption values and availability can change, travelers should compare available options before using their miles.

Understanding Medallion Status

Frequent travelers can work toward Delta Medallion Status, which provides additional benefits and enhanced mileage earning. The current Medallion levels are Silver, Gold, Platinum, and Diamond.

Delta's current earning rates on qualifying Delta-marketed flights are 7 miles per dollar for Silver, 8 for Gold, 9 for Platinum, and 11 for Diamond. Qualification is based on Medallion Qualification Dollars (MQDs), with current published thresholds of \$5,000 for Silver, \$10,000 for Gold, \$15,000 for Platinum, and \$28,000 for Diamond.

Benefits of Medallion Membership

Medallion Status can make frequent travel more comfortable and convenient. Depending on the tier, benefits can include complimentary upgrades, preferred seats, priority services, waived fees, and higher mileage earning.

Medallion Members can be eligible for complimentary upgrades to Delta First, Delta Comfort, and certain premium products when the fare and itinerary qualify. Upgrade priority depends on several factors, including Medallion tier and the purchased travel experience.
