Installation details that make or damage the job

Field conditions always make complex tidy drawings. Your site study must confirm clear opening width and height, wall building and construction, readily available headroom, side area for overviews, and any kind of blockages like air ducts or conduit. 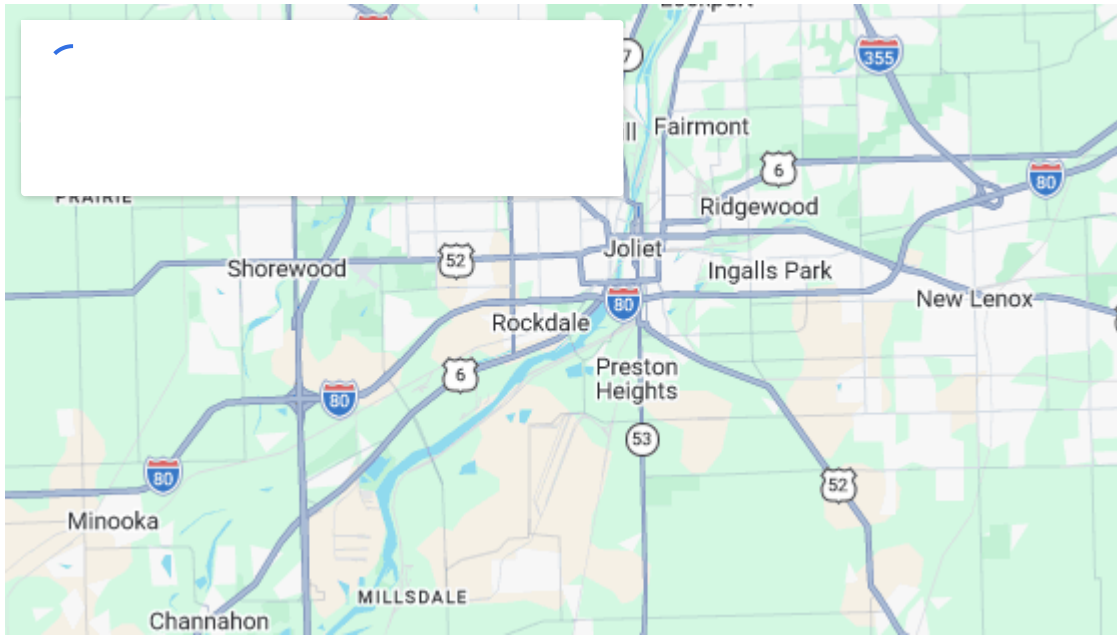

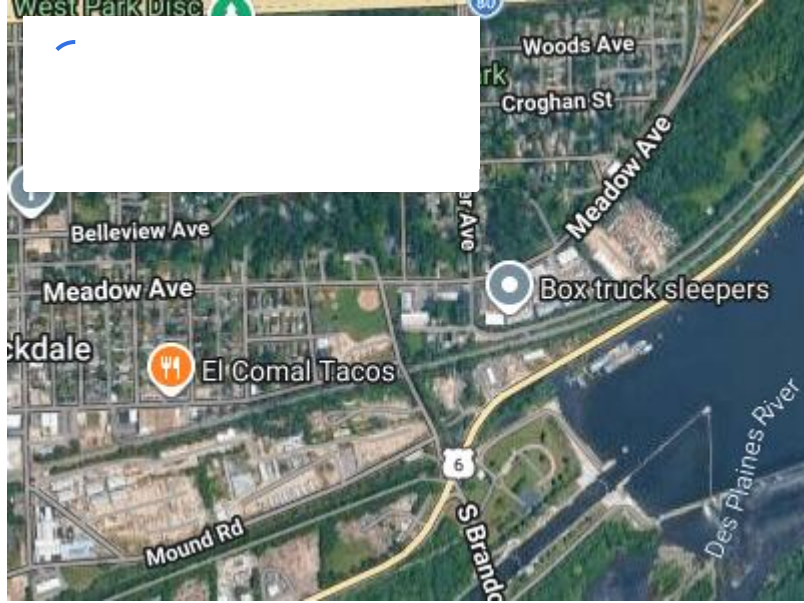
