

Charlotte traffic rarely gives you a quiet day. Between uptown construction, I-77 congestion, and the steady parade of dump trucks and landscaping trailers, your windshield sits in the crossfire. It takes one pebble flung by a passing tire to turn a clean view into a chip with legs. The question isn't whether it happens, but how quickly you respond and who you trust to fix it. Avoid car washes and extreme temperature changes until repair. These small steps improve the odds the chip disappears into the background.
