

A spidering crack across your windshield isn't just ugly. It steals your sightline at the worst possible moment, amplifies glare from the Carolina sun, and can grow from a rock chip to a full-blown fracture faster than a Fort Liberty traffic light change. Repair or replace: the call we make in the parking lot

If a crack touches the edge or runs from it, structural integrity becomes the priority. That glass bonded to the pinch weld helps hold the roof up in a rollover. It's similar with side window repair Fayetteville NC. Side glass is tempered, not laminated, and when it breaks it turns into a thousand pebbles. There's no repairing that. Side window replacement Fayetteville NC is the only route, and the good news is it's typically straightforward and quick. Back glass replacement Fayetteville NC follows the same rule. If your rear defroster grid is a mess of glitter, you're getting a new panel. For some vehicles with laminated rear glass, back glass repair Fayetteville NC can be an option, but it's rare in our market.

Chips, cracks, and the myths that cost people money

I've watched a small rock chip sit harmlessly for months, then spread overnight after a cold snap. The culprit is almost always moisture and temperature swings. A chip that looks like a tiny crater can hide microfractures. Air enters, heat hits the glass, the inner layer expands, and the crack runs. What drives price:
