

A Florida roof does not age quietly. It bakes under intense sun, gets soaked by long stretches of humidity, collects windblown debris, and then grows things you never invited onto it. Dark streaks, green patches, clumps of moss, and that dingy film near the shaded side of the house rarely show up overnight, but once they settle in, they tend to spread fast.

Insurance and inspection conversations are easier with a maintained roof

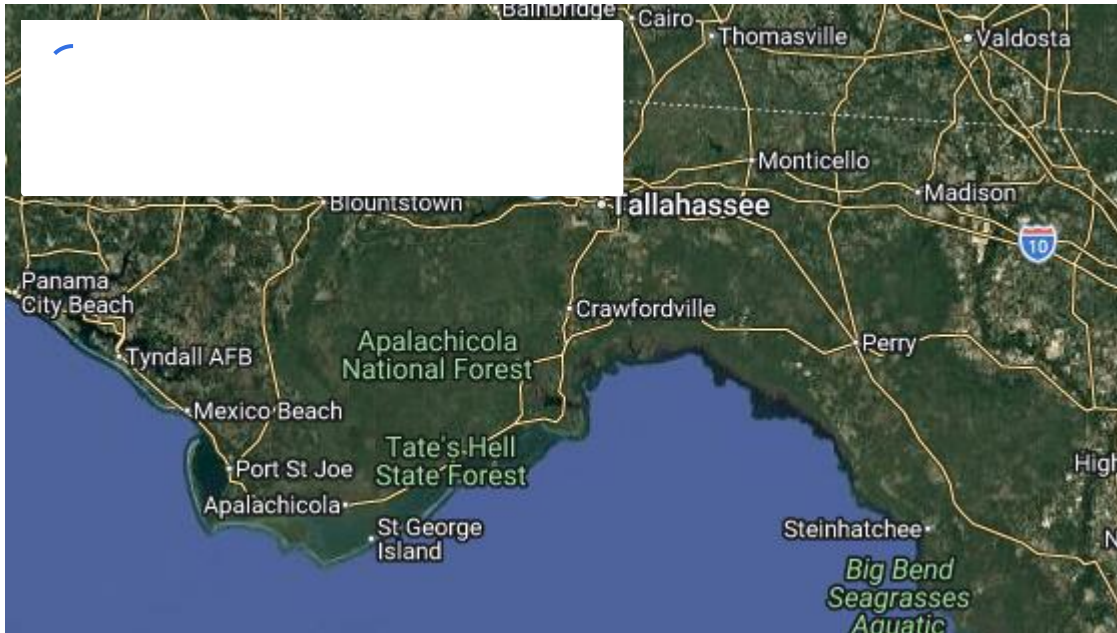
