Wind frequently rises all over noon, then tapers a touch later. Early deck shots lean lighter and drier, water play adds colour and texture, then the ultimate sequence either dresses up a notch or cools into towels, heavier knits, or denim based on the brand vibe. Keep a towel in the coloration wherein it remains usable, no longer baked.

Flash is one can, yet I not often use greater than a small on-camera soar or a handheld LED panel for fill. Big stands and modifiers emerge as kites if the wind alternatives up, and you do not desire a softbox catching a gust on a precise deck. If you ought to use off-digicam pale, avert it hand-held with a wrist strap and station any one as a human increase. For sound on video, a small shotgun mic beats a lav when swimmers start. If you do lav, water-proof the % or wait until the deck pictures.

Alcohol pairs poorly with cold water and lengthy lenses. It's positive to come with a beer or seltzer in candid frames, however prevent heavy consuming for after the last swim. Sunblock is tools. So are electrolyte packets and a cooler with ice.

Noise issues. Music is element of the Lake Travis culture, but blasting throughout the time of golden hour invitations a raft of boats you didn't plan for. Keep amount mild even though shooting, then ramp up among sequences if the vibe demands it. Etiquette extends to wake leadership. In water, shop guidance even shorter. People get chilly sooner than they admit. Plan a greatest of two short dunk sequences per person, every one much less than five mins, with towels pre-situated and a spotter capable at the ladder. Lighting selections that appreciate the lake

Use the lake as a reflector. Position matters so the water throws mushy light lower back into faces. On a peaceful day, this consequence is powerful adequate to skip fill. On a breezy day, trip the attitude and be given a chunk of distinction that provides definition. During golden hour, backlight is king. Put the solar just off a shoulder, enable hair rim, and expose for faces when protective highlights when you can still. The water will flare superbly for those who hold your glass easy.

I bring one small LED with adjustable temperature to add a nudge of fill for tight photos close nightfall. It buys you five to ten excess minutes after the sun dips. Weather, wind, and last-minute pivots

Forecasts around Austin are often sturdy inside of 24 hours, but wind can rise sooner than envisioned. Build a B plan. On one August afternoon, a customer insisted on Devil's Cove at height occasion hours. We pivoted twenty minutes west to a smaller indentation the captain favored. The second we set a stern anchor and pointed the bow into the wind, the water smoothed, the horizon cleared, and the gallery turned from chaotic to polished. Trust your captain's learn.
