

Garage Door Repair Services in Los Angeles

Dependable garage door repair in Los Angeles can safeguard your home, vehicles, and belongings while allowing everyday activities to continue. Frequent Garage Door Problems in West Hollywood and LA

When to Repair or Replace a Garage Door Spring

A spring balances the weight of the door. The two most common types are the **torsion spring**, installed above the door opening, and the **extension spring**, placed along the horizontal tracks. Both can break through normal wear, and neither should be tuned without the correct tools and training.

Symptoms of a broken spring may include a loud snap, a door that will not open, a noticeable gap in the spring, hanging cables, or a door that becomes unusually heavy. If the door has two springs and only one appears broken, a technician may advise replacing both when they have about the same age and wear. This can help support balanced operation, although the ultimate advice depends on the inspection.

The **garage door spring cost** is influenced by spring type, door weight, cycle rating, access, hardware condition, and labor. - Check weather stripping and the bottom weather seal for splits, gaps, or compression. Replace damaged weather seal material to reduce dust, insects, moisture, and heat.
- Watch for frayed cables, loose fasteners, bent tracks, unusual vibration, and variations in operating speed.
- Check the automatic reversal function according to the manufacturer's instructions and leave the opening clear of objects.

Southern California's mild climate does not remove wear. Strong sunlight can bleach painted garage door panels and stiffen seals, while heat and temperature changes can impact lubricants and sensor alignment. Coastal areas such as Santa Monica may also subject metal parts to salty air. Scheduled cleaning, lubrication, and a professional safety inspection can help detect problems before they become emergencies.
