Another client carried a 2.20 carat emerald slice coming from a loved ones ring. The stone was actually somewhat shallow, so it faced up bigger than its carat. Our team created a step-cut halo of 1.0 x 2.0 mm baguettes in platinum eagle, mounted on a hand-

polished 14k white gold shank to maintain price workable and also body weight relaxed. The halo concealed a minor section chip under a V-prong as well as gave the ring a period feeling. They matched it along with a straightforward platinum eagle band so the steels contacting were the same, minimizing galvanic wear.
