What Is Global Entry?

Instead of going through the standard customs and immigration process, approved Global Entry members can use designated processing options at participating airports. This can significantly reduce the amount of time spent waiting after an international flight.

Another important advantage is that Global Entry membership includes TSA PreCheck eligibility for U.S. citizens and certain other eligible travelers. This means one program can provide benefits for both international arrivals and airport security screening.

How Do Global Entry & TSA PreCheck Save Time?

The biggest advantage of Global Entry & TSA PreCheck is convenience. TSA PreCheck can make the departure process easier, while Global Entry can simplify the process of returning to the United States after international travel.

For example, a traveler flying from New York to Europe and back may use TSA PreCheck when departing from a participating U.S. airport. Upon returning, the traveler can use Global Entry processing instead of the regular immigration line, when eligible and available.

The actual time saved varies by airport, travel date, passenger volume, and other factors. However, avoiding standard queues can make the overall airport experience considerably smoother.

While both programs help travelers save time, they serve different purposes. TSA PreCheck focuses primarily on expedited airport security screening for departures from participating U.S. airports. Global Entry focuses on expedited U.S. entry after qualifying international travel and also provides TSA PreCheck eligibility for eligible members.

For frequent international travelers, Global Entry may offer broader benefits. For travelers who mostly fly domestically, TSA PreCheck may be sufficient.
