

A chipped windshield has impeccable timing. It waits for a sand truck on Bragg Boulevard, or the morning you're hustling down Skibo Road to beat traffic, then a pop, and you're suddenly debating resin vs. replacement at a red light. ## Small details that add up to a better outcome

Wiper blades matter more than you think. Swap them after a new windshield. Old blades carry grit that can scratch fresh glass within days. Keep your windshield washer reservoir filled with a quality cleaner, not just water. It keeps bug acid and pine pollen from etching.

If you park under trees, consider a simple cowl screen. Debris piles near the base of the windshield hold moisture against seals, aging them faster. If you use automated car washes, choose touchless during the first week after a replacement to avoid tugging on fresh moldings. On hot days after a replacement, crack a window slightly. It reduces pressure as the interior heats, easing stress on fresh urethane.
