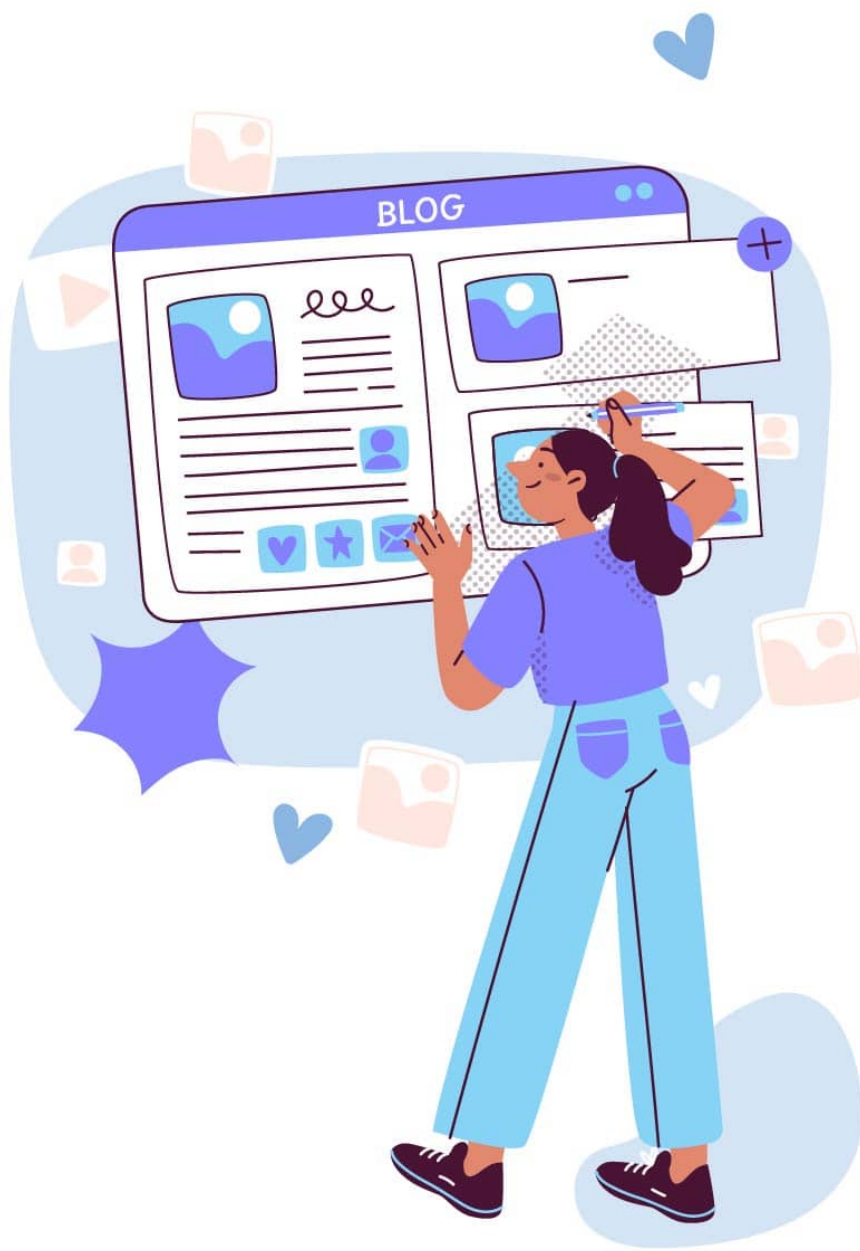
## Top Neighborhoods to Book a Room in Oswego

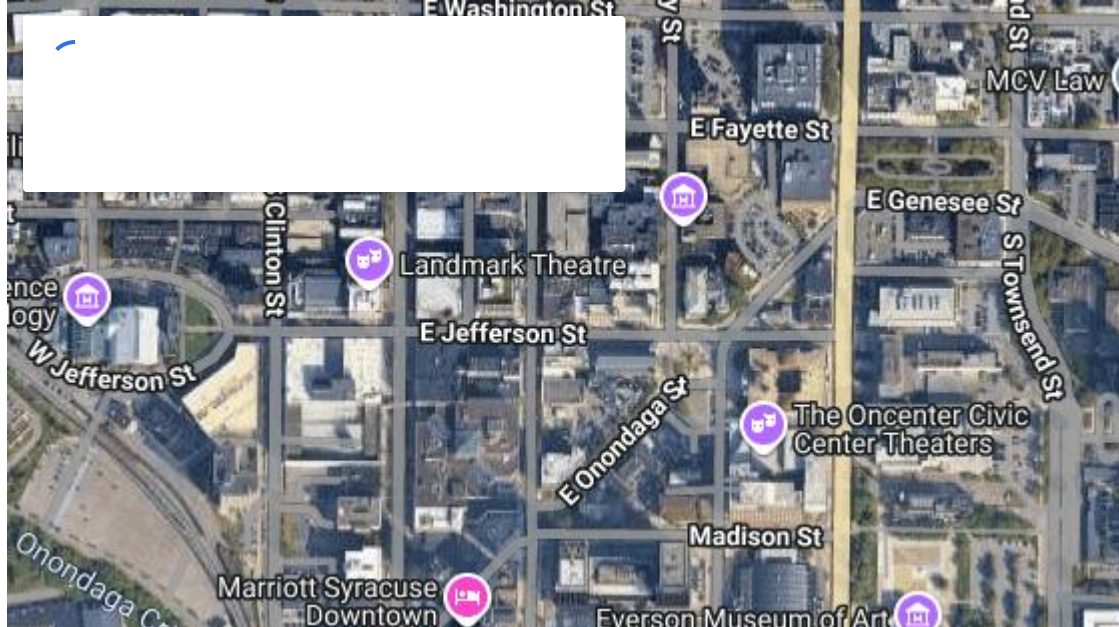
