Common Issues with Cement Tile Roofs

1. Coating Failure and Fading

Cement tiles are porous and rely on protective coatings for waterproofing and colour. UV radiation gradually breaks down these coatings, causing fading, chalking, and increased water absorption.

2. Organic Growth

Once coatings fail, moisture penetrates tiles. Combined with Sydney's humidity, this creates perfect conditions for lichen, moss, and algae. These organisms aren't just unsightly – they accelerate tile deterioration.

3. Cracked and Broken Tiles

Falling branches, hail, thermal stress, and age all cause tile damage. Even small cracks let water through, potentially damaging your home's structure.

4. Deteriorating Bedding and Pointing

Ridge capping is secured with mortar bedding and pointing. Traditional cement-based mortar becomes brittle over time, cracking and losing adhesion.

5. Water Pooling and Leaks

Displaced tiles, blocked valleys, or failed flashing allow water to penetrate. By the time you see ceiling stains, significant damage may have occurred.

The Complete Cement Tile Restoration Process

Step 1: Comprehensive Roof Inspection

We thoroughly examine your entire roof, documenting tile condition, identifying damage, checking ridge capping, examining valleys and flashing, and assessing the existing coating.

Step 2: High-Pressure Cleaning

Using professional equipment, we remove all organic growth, dirt, and failed coatings. This creates a clean surface for new coatings to bond properly.

Step 3: Repairs and Tile Replacement

Damaged tiles are replaced with matching profiles and colours. We repair valley gutters, replace worn flashing, and fix structural issues discovered during inspection.

Step 4: Re-Bedding and Re-Pointing Ridge Capping

Ridge tiles are removed, old brittle mortar is cleared, tiles are re-bedded with modern flexible pointing compound, and pointing is applied for weather protection and aesthetic finish.

Step 5: Applying Quality Sealant or Coating
