The Banker bet offers the lowest house edge at just 1.06%, making it your best statistical choice. While the casino takes a 5% commission on winning Banker bets, this wager still gives you the highest probability of success over time. Player bets come in second with a 1.24% house edge, while Tie bets should generally be avoided due to their steep 14.4% house advantage.

Ignore Pattern Chasing

Many players try to spot trends by tracking previous results on scorecards. They look for streaks or alternating patterns, then bet accordingly. Here's the reality: each hand is completely independent. Past results have zero influence on future outcomes. Those elaborate tracking systems might make the game feel more strategic, but they won't improve your odds. Focus on making mathematically sound bets instead.

Master Your Bankroll

Set a clear budget before you start playing and stick to it religiously. A good rule of thumb is to bring enough money for 20–30 betting units. If you're betting \$25 per hand, bring \$500–750 to the table. Decide on both win and loss limits. When you've doubled your starting [live dealer online casino](#) bankroll, consider walking away. If you lose 50% of your budget, it's time to call it a night.

Practical Tips for Better Results

Start with Lower Stakes

Avoid Side Bets
