



If you have lived in Alexandria for greater than a few seasons, you already recognize the city's plumbing has personality. Block rowhouses conceal cast iron stacks. Mid-century cattle ranch homes mingle copper, galvanized steel, and the periodic mystery PVC. Cellars tease with the groundwater level after a tough rainfall. Include mature tree origins and the clay dirt along the Potomac, and you obtain an ideal recipe for slow drains pipes, recurring clogs, and backed-up drains.
