On moisture, the error I see time and again is stress washing on a Friday and paint on a Saturday. You see blistering, premature peeling at end grain, and tannin hemorrhage on cedar that never clears. On masonry, it pushes water deeper right into the capillary network, after that drives efflorescence back towards the face. I tell customers in Ypsilanti to plan on slightly longer timetables in shoulder seasons, or we stage elevations so each surface gets the completely dry time it needs.

Product flexibility matters because inflexible movies split in January. Premium acrylics outmatch hybrids and oil on a lot of external wood around right here. Masonry requires vapor-permeable finishings that let water out. On trim, a higher-build enamel looks high end yet need to extend with the wood. And for cure windows, 50 to 85 levels with modest humidity is the happy area. The much better lines will tolerate down to the mid-30s, yet drying slows down, pests stick, and dew can haze the sheen. Fiber cement conceals in ordinary sight as wood. Touch it. If it really feels cool and difficult, and the sides are crisp and the nails are less pronounced, you may be considering Hardie or comparable. Below the preparation is about chalk elimination and caulk evaluation. If the last painter caulked the bottom lap lines, that trapped water and needs improvement.
