Why documentation and judgment matter

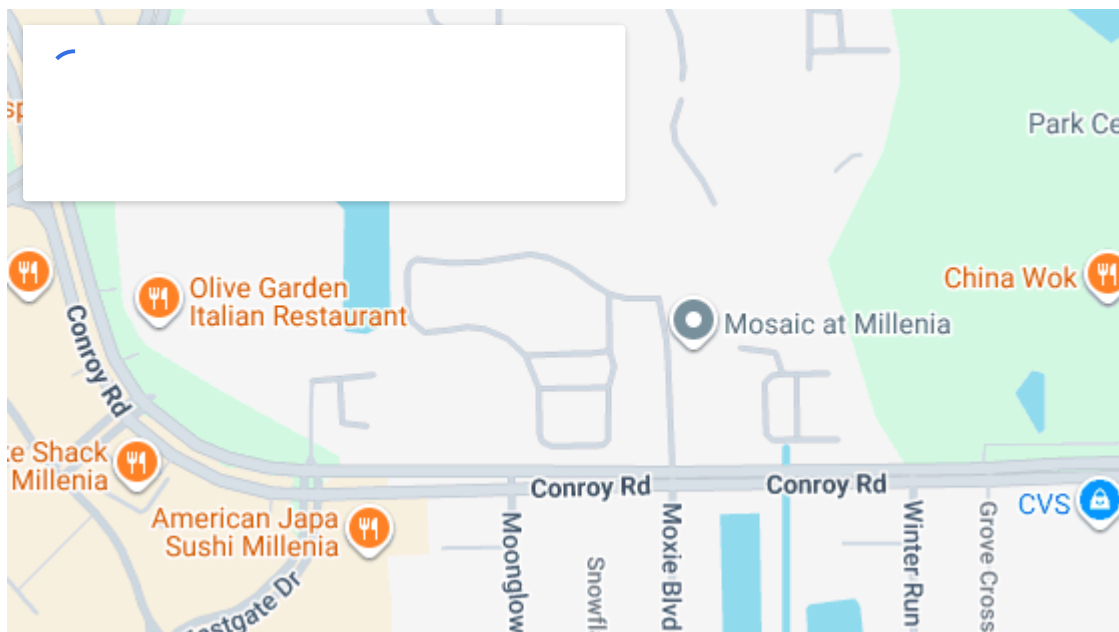
