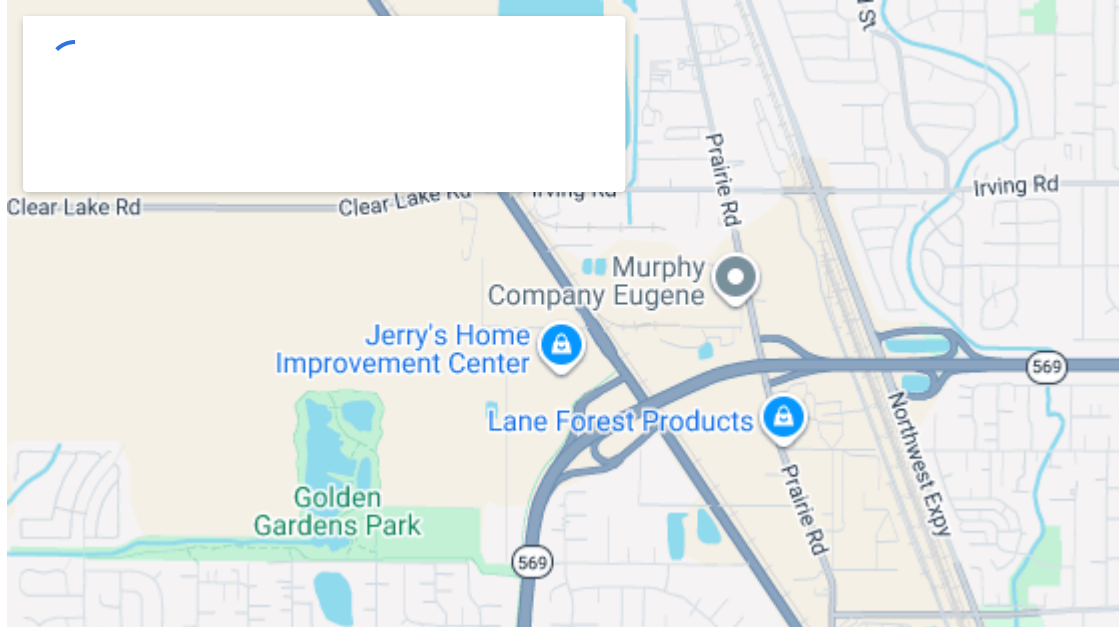
Accessibility, self-respect, and guest expectations
