Spring systems are under considerable tension. Do not cut, unwind, or remove a torsion spring or extension spring yourself. Attempting a DIY repair can cause serious injury or damage to the door. A qualified technician can identify the spring type, confirm the door weight, inspect the bearings and end plates, and complete a balanced garage door spring replacement.

The garage door cable carries spring force to the lifting mechanism. A frayed, broken, or displaced cable can cause one side of the door to rise more than the other. Garage door rollers can also crack, seize, or wear flat, creating friction and vibration. Replacing rollers and cables together may be recommended when both show signs of age.
