Courts

An Initial Hearing is a "program cause" hearing, where the prosecution should persuade the court that there is likely cause that the person charged committed the fees filed in case. This is not a test, and the worry on the prosecution is much lower. If you forgo your right to an Initial Hearing for an offer in case, the offer can not be taken out by the prosecution unless there is a substantial adjustment in case, such as an infraction of bond problems.

After that, when the situation finishes, the bail money is returned to the bondsman. During an apprehension, you will likely be searched, patted down, cuffed, and put in the back of a police vehicle. Nevertheless, the cops do not have to review your Miranda cautions unless they begin questioning you (called "custodial examination").
