



Yacht Charter inside the Central Cyclades

The components winning wind for the period of the summer time months is the notorious Meltemi blowing from the N-NW. It is first felt in June and turns into more advantageous by means of July, August and September while it's going to attain pressure eight. It dies down in October. In the spring and autumn gales are common from the N and the SE. The summer season months are scorching, reasonable temperatures are 25 deg C and temperatures more commonly succeed in 35 deg C.

Milos is the southwesternmost of the Cyclades. A immense bay, Ormos Milou, turned into scooped out whilst an historical [private yacht rentals Cabo San Lucas](#) volcano erupted and scorching sulphur springs nevertheless exist as we speak. Adhamas is the island's port Go bow or stern to the E edge of the ferry pier or bow to the smaller pier to the E. It could also be imaginable to anchor off to the SE of the quick pier. The backside is mud rocks and weed and bad holding in locations. There is ideal preserve from the Meltemi however winds from the south can produce detrimental situations. There is water at the ferry pier and fuel will probably be introduced. Most provisions may well be acquired within the village and there are a few tavernas. Climb the hill to the Chora at Milos for breathtaking views throughout the bay. There are various other anchorages in the bay which might be uncovered to the north. There are no facilities at any of them. Apollonia is inside the NE of Milos. Go bow or stern to the pier or anchor of the sea coast. Holding is good on a sandy backside. There are tavernas and a mini industry ashore. Ormos Voudhia lies one mile to the south of Apollonia. There is nice shield from the Meltemi but the environment are unattractive with open cast mines and a wharf and ore provider all in view.

Kimilos lies to the NE of Milos. There are two anchorages in Ormos Sikia inside the SW of the island. They are uncovered to the N – NW and wrong when the Meltemi is blowing. Pirgonisi is a long sandy seashore on the south coast and yachts can anchor very nearly at any place along it in attractive scenery. Good keeping on sand and weed. Psathi lies similarly along the coast to the east. Go bows to the quay or anchor off. There is little protect from the Meltemi and yachts are counseled to take advantage of this anchorage solely in calm weather. There are more than one tavernas ashore and confined provisions can be got inside the village. Just to the north is Semina Creek and yachts can anchor inside the bay. Like Psathi, there may be little look after from the Meltemi and Psathi should be used simplest in calm climate.

The within the NW of island of Poliagos there may be a lovable secluded anchorage simply to the south of the tiny island of Moanolsi. There is shield from the Meltemi and great holding on the sandy bottom. On the south edge of the island there are a number of coves that yachts can anchor in whilst conditions are calm.

Folegandros is an additional barren, rocky island with exception of the small Chora in the NE that lies between efficient timber and shrubs. The islands ferry port is Karavostasi. Go bow or stern to the mole on the south side of the arm extending westward. There is bad keeping in locations on sand and rock. There is affordable preserve from the Meltemi. There are various tavernas however provisions may also be difficult to download and the island is utterly reliant on deliveries by ferry. On the W side of Folegandros is the considerable bay, Ormos Vathi. It can best be utilized in calm climate and there is terrible holding in areas on sand and weed.

Sikinos lies to the E of Folegandros. Ormos Skala is the simply harbour on the island. Yachts can pass alongside the marina or anchor off. There are tavernas ashore and some provisions will likely be obtained. The environment is horny and commonly used with Greek travelers.

3.5 miles to the east of Sikinos lies Ios. It is claimed Homer is buried right here. He died aboard a ship on passage from Samos to Athens and his body turned into thrown overboard and later washed up on Ios. Go bow or stern to inside the harbour of Port Ios. There is proper retaining in dust. A mini tanker can deliver gas and water is handy from a public fountain in the rectangular. There are tavernas all around the harbour and such a lot provisions may be got. The hotel is customary with the younger and most of the bars play loud track in the evenings/night. Ormos Milopotamou lies to the S of Port Ios. In the north of the bay there are 4 coves in which yachts can anchor, the easterly two offer the preferred shield. Holding is sweet on sand. There are tavernas and motels at the seaside. Ormos Manganari is a substantial bay at the south coast of Ios, it is seemingly to anchor for the time of the bay with impressive retaining on sand. There are tavernas ashore.

Thira is rather like Milos in as a great deal as it's a volcano and when it erupted in 1440 1450 BC it created the bay as this is at this time. The near lying islands of Thirasia, Nea Kammeni and Palaia Kammeni are also part of this good sized volcanic format. Around the basin, on cliffs 300m high it is easy to see white Cycladic residences with blue painted windows placing from black volcanic rocks which upward thrust sheer from the ocean all crew together to make Thira is among the many so much famous destinations in Greece.

Finikia lies inside the N of Thira. Anchor to the W of the mole in 10 20m with a go back and forth line as a result of the base is rocky. Limited preserve from the Meltemi and completely open to the S. Skala Thira is the harbour of the islands capital at the steep slopes above. Go bow or stern to the jetty with a line to the extensive mooring buoy. Departing is elaborate with the confusion of the numerous lines hooked up to the buoy and it truly is suggested that yachts are usually not left unattended. There is water on the quay and various tavernas inside the harbour.

On the coast south of Ak Akrotiri there are a considerable number of anchorages that provide respectable protect from the Meltemi. The bottom is sweet conserving in sand however there is frequently some flooring swell that motives yachts to roll badly. Monolithos is a small harbour on the E coast. Go bows to the breakwater close to its extremity with a long line. There is a taverna and showers ashore.

Thirasia is the westernmost island and the in simple terms anchorage is Ayios Nikolaos. Yachts can anchor off but the small pier is reserved for regional boats. There are tavernas ashore and some provisions are available within the village atop the cliffs.

Nea Kammeni has lots of small inlets where a yacht can anchor. A trip line should be used as the base is strewn with rocks which are possibly to snag an anchor. Nea Kammeni is known for its trouble with monstrous rats and there are various reports of the getting aboard yachts.

Anafi is the southernmost of the Cyclades. It has one anchorage at the S coast that's exposed. The island is barren and parched and you may now not pass over a good deal while you opt for no longer to talk over with.
