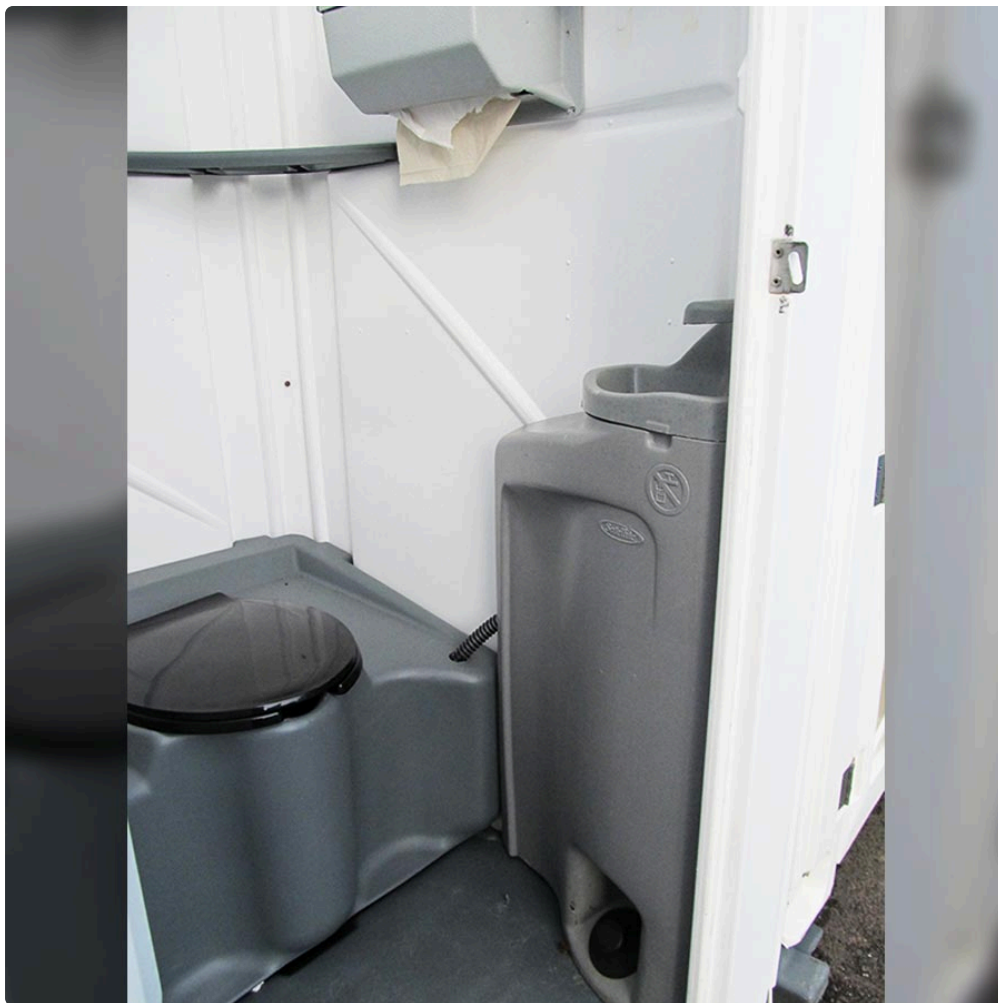
Why restroom preparation impacts the whole event

Cost control without corner-cutting

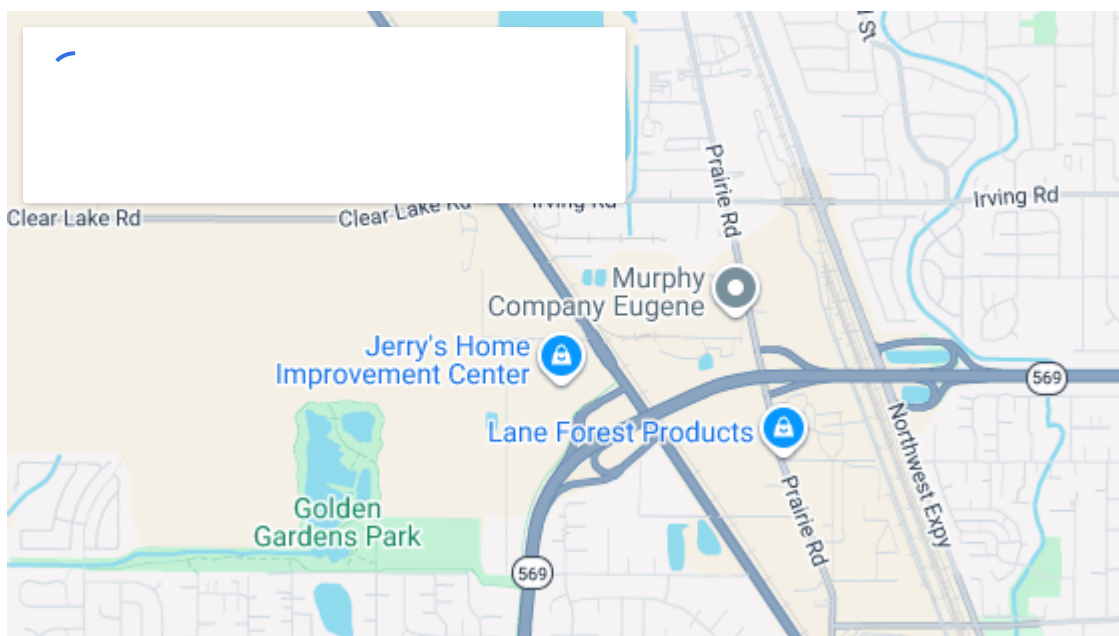
