



If you have resided in Alexandria for more than a few periods, you already recognize the city's plumbing has personality. Brick rowhouses conceal cast iron stacks. Mid-century cattle ranch homes mingle copper, galvanized steel, and the occasional secret PVC. Cellars tease with the water level after a tough rainfall. Throw in fully grown tree origins and the clay soil along the Potomac, and you get an ideal dish for slow-moving drains, repeating clogs, and backed-up sewers. Picking the right drain cleaning company is not about a fast snake and a farewell. In clay laterals with roots, you do not wish to ram the cable television so hard that it broadens a joint. The objective is controlled reducing, not brute force.

Once flow is recovered, the electronic camera tells the truth. I have actually found offsets that just obstruct when a washing device discharges at full speed, and bellies that hold simply adequate water to catch paper for weeks. Without a video camera, you may assume the blockage is arbitrary and brace for the next one.
