4. Heat, vacuum, and pressure well balanced for our climate

You can hear an effective truckmount from the driveway, however raw power isn't enough. Carpet cleaners require to balance three variables: heat, water pressure, and vacuum. Excessive heat can set certain dyes or impact protectants.
