3. Explain why you missed the flight.

6. Check whether your original itinerary has been canceled.

Acting quickly is important. Waiting too long can reduce your available options.

If you believe the missed flight resulted from an airline-related issue, contact Frontier promptly. Explain what happened and ask whether you qualify for a refund or another remedy.

What Information Should You Have Ready?

Keep these details available when requesting assistance:

- Confirmation code
- Passenger name
- Original flight number
- Travel date
- Reason for missing the flight
- Any relevant disruption information

Providing accurate information can make the conversation easier.

Does Frontier Offer Missed Flight Compensation?

[Frontier missed flight compensation](#) depends on the circumstances. Missing a flight because you arrived late at the airport does not automatically create a compensation entitlement.

The situation may be different when the missed connection or travel disruption resulted from an airline-related problem.

Ask the airline to explain what assistance applies to your specific booking. Avoid assuming that compensation is available before your situation is reviewed.
