What a thorough gutter cleaning should include

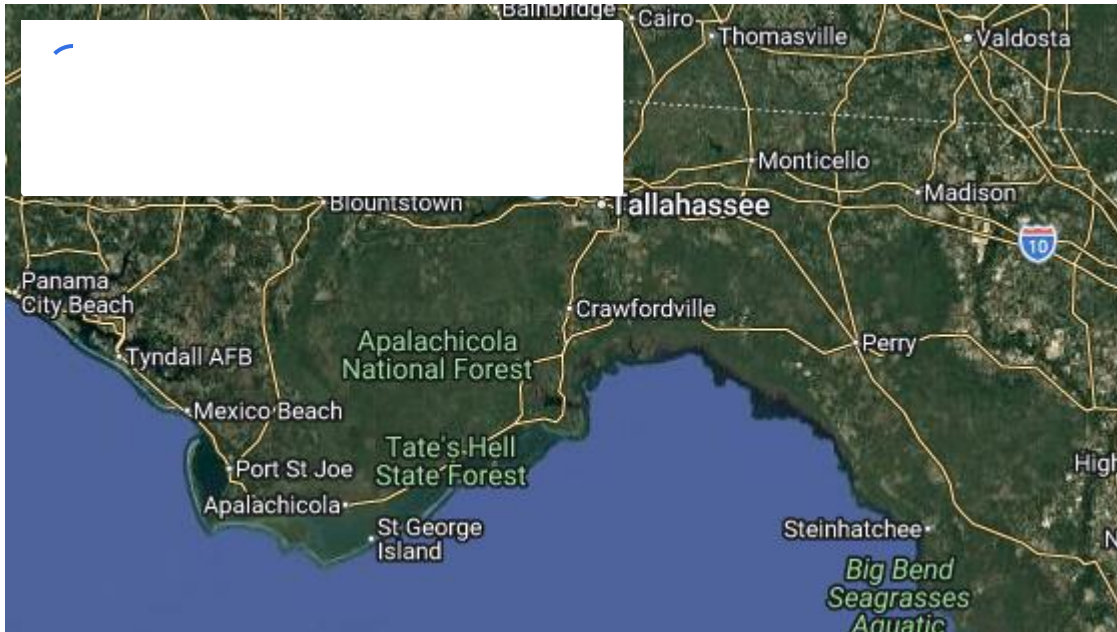

Small warning signs homeowners should not ignore

Most gutter problems give some kind of clue before they become severe. The clues are easy to miss if you are not looking for them, but once you know what they are, they tend to stand out.

Water spilling over the front edge during moderate rain is the classic sign. Another common one is staining on siding or fascia beneath the gutter line. You may also notice plants growing where they definitely should not, right in the gutter itself. That happens when decomposed debris has been sitting long enough to act like soil. It is more common than people think.

One homeowner might notice a puddle near the foundation after every storm and assume the yard just drains poorly. Another may see mulch displaced in the same area again and again. Often the real culprit is a clogged or slow downspout sending too much water to one spot. I have also seen cases where people believed they had a roof leak because water was appearing near a window or entry point, when the actual issue was gutter overflow backing up along the roof edge.
