- Cabin and fare type

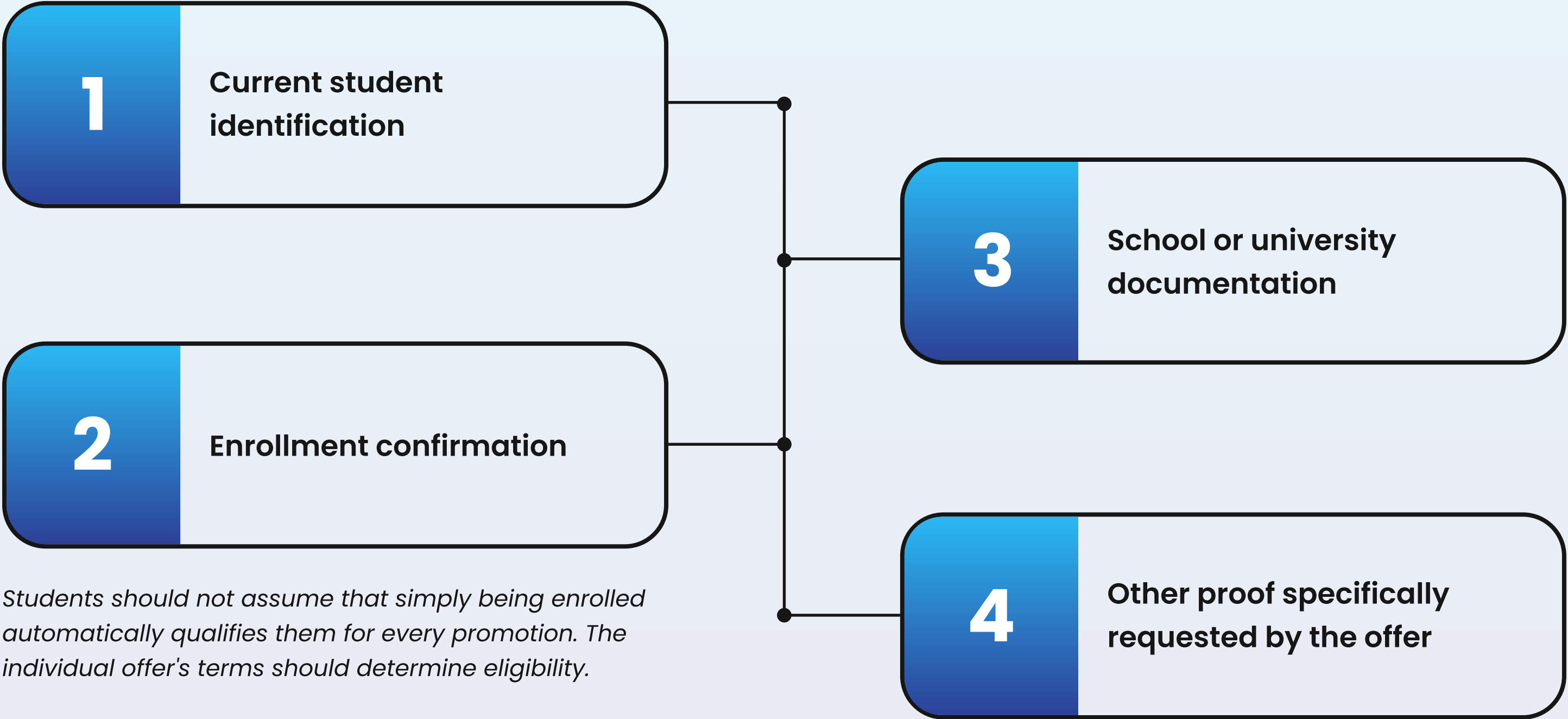
Always review the fare terms before completing a purchase.
