The site had a solid dominating wind angle and a large open yard. A fully solid fencing looked excellent in the make, yet it would certainly have developed added wind lots on the articles. We wound up with a style that still offered personal privacy, just with a slightly much more breathable pattern, and we matched the blog post spacing as necessary. The result held up much better and the structure acted the method you desire when Melbourne climate gets moody.

If you are selecting between products, align your decision with your actual priorities. Colorbond-style steel is typically chosen for low maintenance and directly, sturdy lines. Lumber can look warmer and extra "natural," however it requests for upkeep preparation, like discolor or oil, normal monitoring, and handling activity over time.

Boundaries: the part everyone underestimates
