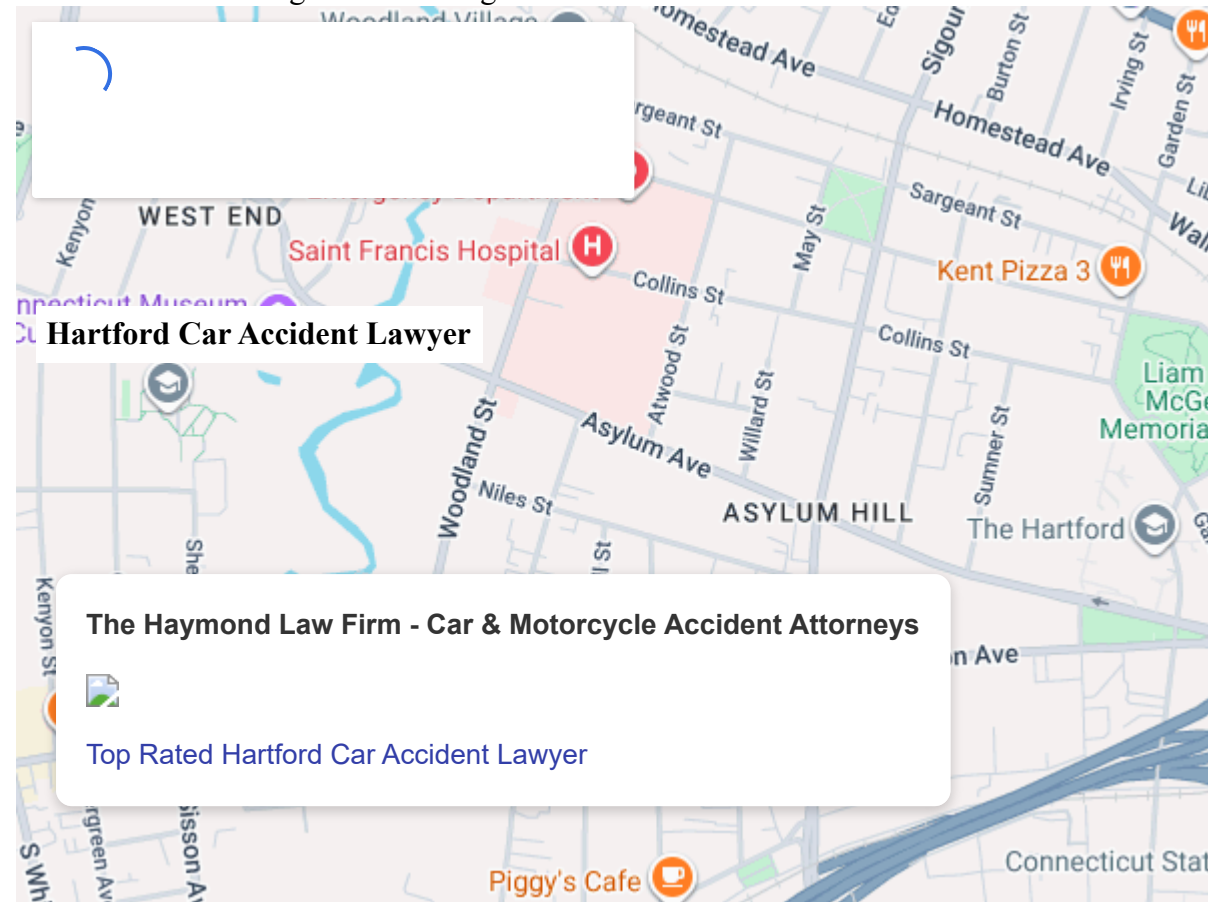

The court or magistrate will decide about bond for the juvenile. The court might release the adolescent on Pre-Trial Release (PTR) under the supervision of team. Most of the times, either a bond quantity is set or the juvenile is approved a PTR.
