At a manufacturing plant along with a new press product line, the sustaining grade shafts resolved within pair of months. Borings revealed loose backfill over stiff clay. Resistance pile screening showed irregular refusal as a result of reduced superstructure bunch in the first weeks, so our company changed to helical piles for the level shafts and also micropiles under the column bases that brought the hefty press tons. Setup finished in four evenings while the plant ran time work schedules along with a skeleton crew around the work region.
